

EPA Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act of 1986 Compliance

The Shelby County Board Of Education remains in compliance with EPA's Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) of 1986. The system school has conducted three year re-inspections, six month periodic surveillances and the training of employees as required by EPA's AHERA regulations.
