

EPA Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act of 1986 Compliance

The Shelby County Board Of Education remains in compliance with EPA's Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act of 1986. The system conducting the three year re-inspections in accordance with EPA's AHERA Act in February, 2013. Six month periodic surveillance was conducted in July, 2013 and the training of employees will continue as needed.

Asbestos abatement activities have been conducted at Montevallo Elementary School, Wilsonville Elementary School, Inverness Elementary School, Helena Elementary School, Calera Elementary School, Calera Intermediate School, Pelham High School and Shelby County High School in the past 12 months.
