This summer the Community Education Department of Shelby County Schools will be offering Driver Education and Health classes. The classes will be held at the Shelby County Instructional Services Center in Alabaster and taught by high school Driver Education and Health teachers from the Shelby County School System.

**Driver Education:** Morning class held from 7 a.m. to noon the first week of each session.

First session - May 29 to June 15

Second session - June 25 to July 13

**Driver Education:** Afternoon class held from 12:30 to 5:30 the first week of each session. These spots will be reserved for high school athletes that have morning practice.

First session - June 4 to June 22

Second session – June 25 to July 13

The first week is class work. There will be some driving in the afternoons of the first week. The other two weeks will be just for driving and each student will be given a schedule for when to return. **IF** your child wants our instructor to give the Driver's test, it will be given. Be sure to have them bring their permit the first day of class. For the morning class bring a snack, drink, and lunch. Some students will be driving that first day. The parents will be notified by 11 if that is the case.

Fee: \$360.00 - price includes a gas fee.

**Health:**

First session – June 4 to June 22

Second session – June 18 to July 13

Health class will start at 1 p.m. on first day for orientation and to receive packets, books and directions. Student will then do a self-directed study. They may meet with the instructor midway through to check students' progress.

Fee: \$200.00

**Each class** will receive a grade in addition to a half Carnegie unit for taking the course. To pre-register fill out the registration form and attach checks made out to Community Education.
