Oak Mountain High School will be open on Saturday, August 4 from 9:00-11:00 A.M. for parents and students to come to the school and walk personal schedules. It is also a time for students to make sure they are comfortable working their lockers. Discipline/Attendance Overview:

Dress Code at OMHS – Things to Remember

- **NO** revealing garments
- **NO** sleeveless for boys
- **NO** shoulder straps less than three fingertips in width for girls
- **NO** short skirts, shorts, or dresses. They **MUST** be fingertip or longer length in the **FRONT AND BACK**
- **NO LEGGINGS** with short shirts or t-shirts. If the top is not appropriate without the leggings on- then do not wear the leggings.
- **NO** pajama pants, snap-aways, gym shorts, etc.
- **NO** pants that are too tight or too loose
- **NO** garments with inappropriate content
- **NO** hats/head coverings
- **NO** inappropriate footwear
- **NO** facial/body piercings (ears are okay)
- **NO** clothing that reveals undergarments
- **NO** unnatural hair colors

Attendance Reminders

Absences

- Attendance is looked at two ways: Full Day and Per Period.
- All absences must have an excuse.
- If you miss one period of the day, you must have an excuse for that period.
- Makeup work is not allowed for unexcused absences.
- Excuses are to be turned in within 3 days of the day you return to school! This includes full-day absences or check-ins/check-outs.
 - Doctor note, parent note, court note – parent notes must give a reason for the excuse.
 - **VERY IMPORTANT:** After a student's 12th absence in the year, parent notes are no longer accepted. It may only be a doctor or court note.
- Pre-Planned absences – Some absences may be approved in advance by completing a pre-planned absence form (blue form). The form must be completed in advance of the absence.
- Makeup Work – It is the student's responsibility to get makeup work within three days of his/her return to school.

Tardies

- **Tardies to School** – arriving after 7:40 (first period only) without an allowable excuse
 - Traffic or vehicle issues are not considered allowable by state regulations.
 - Tardies start over at the beginning of each nine weeks.

- **Tardies to Class** – arriving after the tardy bell (periods 2-8)
 - Tardies start over at the beginning of each nine weeks.
