

SHELBY COUNTY COMMUNITY EDUCATION

This summer the Community Education Department of Shelby County Schools will be offering Driver Education and Health classes. The classes will be held at the Shelby County Instructional Services Center in Alabaster and taught by high school Driver Education and Health teachers.

Information (Please keep)

Morning Driver Education: First session will be held from 7 a.m. to noon the first 5 days of first session. Third session will be Mon and Friday 7 am to noon. Tues, Wed. & Thurs. will be 11 to 4.

Afternoon Driver Education: Class will be held from 12:30 to 5:30 the first 5 days of each session. These spots will be reserved for high school students that have morning activities.

1st– 5/26 to 6/12 2nd- 6/1 to 6/19 3rd – 6/ 15 to 7/3 4th- 6/22/ to 7/10

The first 5 days is class work. The remaining days of each session will be just for driving and each student will be given a set schedule they help make for when to return each time to drive. The schedule is set for the benefit of all members of the class and needs to be followed as closely as possible. Students must bring their **permit, paper, pencil, snack and a drink** the first day of class. Some students will be driving that first day of the morning class. The parents will be notified by 11 if that is the case.

Fee: \$360.00 - price includes a gas fee. If your check has been processed, you are in the class you chose. Otherwise you will be contacted.

Health: First session – June 1 to June 19 Second session – June 15 to July 17

Health class will start at 1 p.m. on first day for orientation and to receive packets, books and directions. Student will then do a self-directed study. They may meet with the instructor midway through to check students' progress. If there is enough interest or need, there will be another class which will start at 2:30 p.m.

Fee: \$200.00

Each class will receive a grade in addition to a half Carnegie unit for taking the course. To pre-register fill out the registration form and attach checks made out to Community Education. Some payment is required to hold your spot.
